FLOOD PREPARATION

Before a flood may occur call your insurance carrier to make sure you are covered in case of flooding or damage.

Learn and practice evacuation routes.

Build an emergency supply kit in case you have to leave immediately.

Keep important documents in waterproof containers.

Protect your property by:

Moving valuables to higher levels.

Declutter your drains and gutters.

Install check valves in your plumbing to prevent floodwater from backing up into the drains of your home.

Construct barriers such as levees, berms, and flood walls to stop floodwater from coming into your home or office building.

Fact vs. Fiction

Fiction:

Fill your sinks and bathtubs with water in case flooding water contaminates the public water supply.

Fact:

Water stored in bathtubs or sinks should never be used for drinking or bathing children because lead can leak from the glaze in bathtubs into the water. Instead, use the water for flushing toilets or washing clothing.
